DETAILS

PREVIEW

This summer, 100 selected Public Safety Cadets will have the unique opportunity to participate in the first Public Safety Cadets National Leadership Academy. Public Safety Cadet Mentors are needed to serve as squad leaders. **Mentors are volunteers** and will be housed at the George Mason University's Fairfax, Virginia campus and meals will be provided.

ELIGIBILITY

The Mentor must be registered with Public Safety Cadets and have the endorsement of their partnering agency, must pass a background check, and be available August 4th, 1300 hours, through August 10th, 1300 hours. Mentors will serve as Squad Leaders for Cadets.

SELECTION PROCESS

Each application will be reviewed by a selection process using law enforcement executives composed of members of the Public Safety Cadets National Committee – Law Enforcement Sector, and the applicant will be notified by June 15, 2019, or earlier. Mentor positions will be filled as qualified applicants are processed until capacity. Additional Mentors may be placed in an alternate status.

ACADEMY CONTENT

The Academy will consist of interactive workshops, dynamic lectures, physical fitness, and field trips around the National Capitol Region. Lessons taught throughout the week will provide historic reference to leadership and failures of leadership in law enforcement. Cadets will visit the FBI Academy in Quantico, Virginia, the National Law Enforcement Museum, the National Museum of African American History and Culture, and take part in a leadership lessons walking tour of select monuments in Washington, D.C.

PLAN

The Academy will begin with a group meeting on Sunday afternoon August 4. The instructional portion will last through late morning of August 10. Mentors will be provided with a single occupancy room and all meals will be provided during the Academy.

UNIFORM

Mentors are requested to bring their departmental uniform (if an active law enforcement officer). Mentors will also be supplied with Academy shirts to wear during the week. Additionally, Mentors should bring their own tan BDU style pants and/or shorts.

FIREARMS

Firearms are not permitted in the residence halls of George Mason University except when worn by an active law enforcement officer in uniform. Officers travelling with firearms are responsible for bringing adequate locking storage. During the Academy, firearms may only be worn by sworn, active law enforcement officers in ***their duty uniform***. All of the external facilities we are visiting have strict rules on firearms. Sworn, armed, local police officers will be with the Academy during the entire week for security.
