



2023 PUBLIC SAFETY CADETS NATIONAL MARKSMANSHIP COMPETITION

Firearms Training Certification

In order for Cadets/Explorers to be eligible to compete in the 2023 Public Safety Cadets National Marksmanship Competition, a qualified Firearms Instructor, certified by a federal, state, county, or municipal government or the National Rifle Association of America (NRA) and the Unit Lead Mentor/Advisor must attest that each Cadet/Explorer has received a minimum of eight (8) hours of instruction in, but not limited to: fundamentals of marksmanship, safe range operations, target scoring, firearms safety, nomenclature, necessity of proper clothing, eye and ear protection, as well as proper loading of magazines. Additionally, each Cadet/Explorer must have successfully demonstrated the safe and proper handling of a semi-automatic pistol through completion of at least two Public Safety Cadets Center Fire Pistol Courses (PSCCFPC). Competitive Relays will be selected from the aggregate of the two highest PSCCFPC scores submitted.
